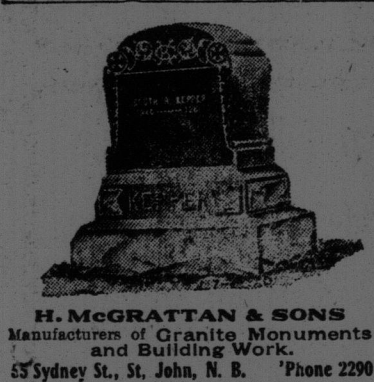

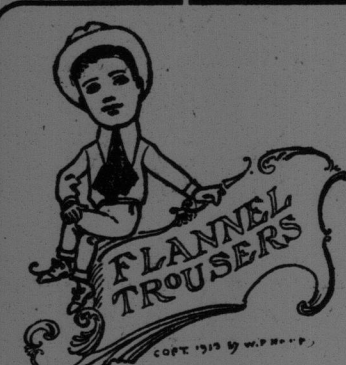

KING AND QUEEN TO REVIEW BIG LINERS AT LIVERPOOL

Notable Inspection in the Mersey To Take Place Next Month

London, June 14—The Liverpool Steamship Owners' Association has issued particulars of the arrangements made for providing a great display of Liverpool liners and other vessels, which will be inspected in the Mersey by the king and queen on the occasion of their visit to the port in July. The association formed a committee at the request of the Earl of Derby, and the committee sent out invitations to all ship-owners in Liverpool to send vessels to take part in the review. A very general response has been made, although there are many firms which, from unavoidable causes, are unable to enter vessels for the purpose. Many of the biggest passenger steamers plying on important routes will, however, be included.

Altogether, twenty-six big ocean-going steamers are included, and in addition there will be a large number of miscellaneous smaller craft and steam and sail yachts. The steamers alone will form an impressive line five miles in length. Their Majesties will embark on the dock board's yacht "Galatea," and will steam round the line of vessels. All ships will be decorated rainbow fashion, and will fly house flags.

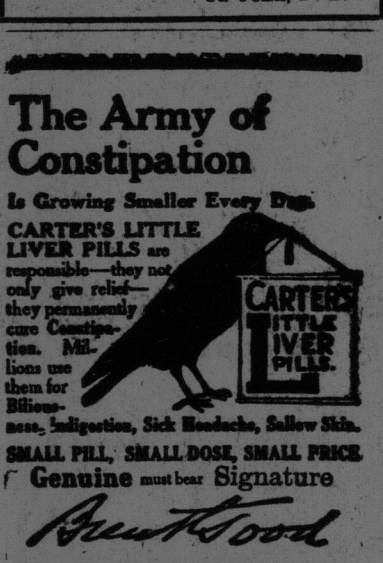
