#### CLOSING STOCK LETTER.

New York, March 12.—Today's stock market remained extremely dull but the general undertone showed rather surprising strength in view of the bearish sentiment prevailing upon the floor and the absence of any stimulating news. After yesterday's selling movement which appeared to have been largely of professional origin, the supply of stocks has again become scarce and while the fear of an anthracite coal strike and a consequent interruption of business at large tends to repress fresh bullish initiative, actual bad news has little or no effect. It looks as if a strong technical position had been restored and that the only requisite just now is a cessation of bad news or the advent of some fresh favorable influence. The anthracite wags question will be given a great deal of attention by financial interests for the immediate future, and may prove an element of disturbance until it has been definitely settled. With this factor removed the prospect favors continued improvement of business at large and higher prices in the stock market.
