

LAW 8. The Chair shall state every question coming before the Company, and immediately before taking the vote shall ask "Is the Company ready for the question?" and should no member rise to speak he shall take the question, and after it has been taken no member shall speak upon it, unless by consent of the Company. He shall pronounce the vote and decisions of the Company upon all subjects.

LAW 9. A motion to adjouru shall always be in order, except when a member is speaking or a vote is being taken, and shall be decided without debate. If no time be specified it shall be until the next Regular Meeting.

LAW 10. Any member may call another to order while speaking, when the debate shall be suspended until the point of order is determined; should the Chair confirm the call, appeal may be made to the Company, and the objectionable words, if required, be taken down in writing by the Secretary. Any member may appeal from the decision of the Chair on a point of order; the question shall be—"Do you sustain the Chair?" and it shall be decided by a majority without debate.

LAW 11. When it is voted to lay any subject on the table it cannot be taken up at the same meeting unless by a two-third vote of the members present.

LAW 12. All members shall provide themselves with the uniform of the Company within sixty days after their enrollment.
