" And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that # from and after the passing of this Act, an Ordinance of the late " Province of Quebec, passed in the Twenty-feventh year of " His Majesty's Reign, intituled, ' An Ordinance for better re-" gulating the Militia of this Province, and rendering it of more " general utility towards the preservation and fecurity thereof;" " and alfo another Ordinance, passed in the twenty-ninth year of " His Majesty's Reign, intituled, ' An Act or Ordinance to explain " and amend an Act, intituled, "An Act or Ordinance for better " regulating the Militia of this Province, and rendering it of more " general utility towards the prefervation and fecurity thereof;" " and alfo, an Act of the Legislature of this Province, passed in " the thirty-fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act " to provide for the greater fecurity of this Province, by the better " regulation of the Militia thereof, and for repealing certain Acts " or Ordinances relating to the fame;' and alfo, another Act pafsed " in the thirty-sixth year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intitul-" ed, " An Act to continue and amend an Act passed by the Legis-" lature of this Province, in the thirty-fourth year of His Majesty's " Reign, intituled, An Act for the greater fecurity of this Province " by the better regulation of the Militia thereof, and for repealing " certain Acts or Ordinances relating to the fame,' shall be and " are hereby repealed."

" And be it further enacted by the authority afore-" said, that this Act shall be and continue in force from " the passing thereof, until the first day of July, which will be " in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, " and no longer: Provided always, that if at the term above " fixed for the expiration of this Act, the Province shall be in a " state of war, invasion or insurrection, the faid Act shall con-" tinue and be in force until the end of such war, invasion or " insurrection."

From this time, the following is a table of the continuations and limitations of the duration of the Militia Acts and Amendments :
