

- Transmission of the complaint, &c., to the Court appealed to. XLV. Immediately after service of the petition, the Clerk of the Municipality, shall without delay transmit to the Clerk of the Court to which the appeal is made the complaint and the evidence in support thereof, together with a certified copy of the decision of the Municipal Council in the matter of the said complaint. 5
- Hearing and judgment. XLVI. On the day of the return of the petition before the Court, the Court shall with consent of the parties or of the appellant if the other parties fail to appear, appoint a day for hearing the matter, and shall on such day determine the matter as to law and right may appertain with costs taxed. 10
- Judgment to be final. XLVII. The judgment of the Court shall be final and conclusive.
- Costs of appeal. XLVIII. The party who shall have obtained judgment in his favor may recover the amount of the costs incurred by him in the manner in which costs of appeal in civil matters may be recovered in the section of the province wherein the decision of the Court which shall have heard the appeal has been given. 15

#### TITLE IV.

##### *Time when elections shall take place.*

- All writs of election to be issued on the same day. XLIX. For the future, when a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly shall take place, from any cause whatsoever, the writs of election shall all issue on the same day, which shall be the day after the expiration or dissolution of a Parliament. 20
- When they must reach the Returning Officer. L. They shall be in the hands of the different Returning Officers on the day after they shall have been issued.
- Nomination day. LI. The nomination of candidates shall take place in all the Electoral Colleges on the day after the day of the issuing of the writs, or on the following day, if the day be a Sunday or 25 legal holiday.
- When the polling shall begin. LII. In all Electoral Colleges in which a contest shall occur, the polling shall commence on the day after the nomination of candidates, or on the following day, if the day be a Sunday 30 or legal holiday.
- Return of the writs. LIII. The writs shall all be returnable on the day after the day for the nomination of candidates, and on the following day, if the day be a Sunday or legal holiday.
- Holidays. LIV. Sundays and holidays of obligation are included in the intervals named in the five preceding sections. 35
