inhabitant-householders of any place men- 2
tioned in such Proclamation, or being within 3
any part of this Province designated therein, 4
or of necessity included thereby, that the 5
Mayor, Townreeve, or other Head of such 6
Municipal Corporation, or Inspecting Trus- 7
tee, or other Chief Municipal Officer of 8
such place, has failed to comply with such 9
requisition as aforesaid, within such time 10
as aforesaid, it shall thereupon become and 11
be lawful for His Excellency in Council, 12
forthwith to appoint not less than three 13
persons resident within the limits of such 14
place, or, in the case of a City, Town or 15
Village, within seven miles thereof, to be 16
and to be called "The Local Board of 17
Health," for such place: Provided always, 18
that every nomination or appointment of a 19
Local Board of Health, under this Act, shall 20
ipso facto be revoked or determined by the 21
revocation, as to the place within the limits 22
of which such Local Board shall be autho- 23
rized to act, or as to any part of this Pro- 24
vince in which the same shall be included, or 25
the whole of this Province, as the case may 26
be, of the Proclamation under which such 27
Local Board shall have been nominated or 28
appointed, or by the expiration of six calen- 29
dar months from the date of such Proclama- 30
tion, or of such shorter period as may have 31
been expressed in such Proclamation, unless 32
in either case such Proclamation be renewed 33
as to such place, or any part of this Pro- 34
vince in which the same shall be included, 35
or the whole of this Province, as the case 36
may be.

V. And be it enacted, That the Central 37
Board of Health, or any or more Members 38
thereof, may from time to time issue such 39
directions or regulations as they shall think 40
fit, for the prevention, as far as possible, or 41
mitigation of such epidemic, endemic or 42
contagious diseases, and revoke, renew, or 43
alter any such directions or regulations, or 44
substitute such new directions and regu- 45
lations as to them or any of them may 46
appear expedient; and the said Board may
