

## Lady Dunn Extention Contrary To Report

A new four storey wing is to be built on the present Lady Dunn Girls residence this year at an estimated cost of two million dollars.
The new wing will resemble a four storey U-shaped building donc up exteriorly with a new shade of dull red brick. There will be room for 200 more female students in the building which already accommodates 220 women students. The new wing will also supply study and lounge facilities for non-residence women students, an innovation thought to be unique among Canadian University residences.

The students are under no obligation to take advantage of the campus medical services but may attend any Fredericton doctor of their choice.

The university students at the present time are not covered by a comprehensive medical care plan. The existing Blue Cross program covers tudents for surgery medical ervices, in-hospital physician ervices, in-hited diagnostic and services, services up to $\$ 25.00$ in any twelve months, $\$ 25.00$ in any up to $\$ 75.00$ physiother and dental care for per year, injuries.
