

have a Reserve near Pigeon Lake,
within the limits of Treaty N: 6.

That the Commissioners
found, upon inquiry, ^{that the facts} were as stated
by the Chief, and from what they could
learn of the feeling of the Blackfeet
toward the Crees, they considered it
advisable to keep them as far separate
as possible; and that it would therefore
be most expedient for Chief Bobtail
and his Band to give in their adhesion
to the Treaty of last year.

The Minister states that
an instrument to that effect was
executed bearing date the 25th day of
September 1877, and herewith submitted;
and he recommends its acceptance
by Your Excellency in Council.
