have a Resurve near Digeon Lake, within the limits of Treaty nº 6. That the commissioners found, upon inquiry, were as stated by the chief, and from what they could learn of the feeling of the Machfeet low and the crees, they considered it advisable to keep them as for separate as possible; and that it would therefore be most expedient for chief Boblail and his Band to give in this adhesion to the duaty of last year. The Minister states that an instrument to that effect was carecuted bearing date the 25 day of September 1877, and herewith submitted and he recommends its acceptance by you callence in formil. The
