Sir,

I have the honor to enclose here -
with a copy of a letter given by the
Honorable James McRay to George Piscett,

The original of this document was shown
to Lieut. Govr. Morris, and (I think) the Minister of
the Interior at Dr' Appelle. Though it was
unsigned, Lieut. Governor Morris said he had no
doubts as to its being the instructions given to
Piscett, and which he had acted under. He
said that Mr McRay acknowledged that he
had sent Piscett after the Lord on the occa-
sion of their visit to Governor Archibald, when they
had gone away without having had an interview.
