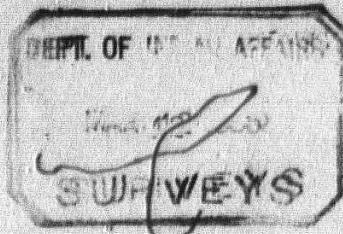

Dear Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 1st ultimo advising that some steps are being taken to extend the County road system through the Seagow Reserve, a distance of 1 1/2 miles.

In this connection I have to request that you inform the County road officials that no improvements to roads should be undertaken within the boundary of the reserve, before the whole scheme has been submitted here for approval, together with a detailed specification and estimate of the cost of the work proposed.

This is necessary as it is expected that refusal would have to be made to the Provincial Government, as is the case with county highways.
