Flying time 304:35 hours. Night flying washed out.</p> <p>Edenvale: Flying washed in at 1800 hours. Washed out at 1630 hours. Flying time 19:05 hours.</p> <p>At 1620 hours Harvard 11 2861 groundlooped on the Main Aerodrome as oil shot up onto the windshield and into the student's face, thus blinding him. It is thought that perhaps an elec leg snapped on touching down and oil from this flew up onto the windshield. The pilot GB1605975 LAC Heard, P.M. was uninjured. D category crash.</p>
