

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant, with reference to the above, and note that the Registrar of Land Titles at Kamloops will not register the Crown Patent granted to Charles Noel for a portion of the Slesh Indian Reserve No. 1.

This whole Indian reserve question is now in process of settlement between the Provincial and Federal Governments, and I would suggest that you advise your client to hold his patent until such time as a settlement is reached. It will then be possible, no doubt, for him to secure the necessary registration.
