is to be established, that it be a common system for the whole of Canada, and that, of necessity, would entail conferences between the federal and provincial authorities;

Therefore, your Committee recommend that the investigation of the subject be continued, in order to determine whether it be possible to co-ordinate the various systems of rural oredit now in existence into a Federal System, applicable to the whole of Canada.
