In reply to your letter of the 17th instant, I have to inform you that by the terms of the Roman Treaty of 1850 the annuities to be paid and delivered to the Chiefs who were parties to the same on behalf of themselves and bands and their tribes and that by the Indian Act 1876 Section 34 if any Indian woman marrying an Indian of any other band comes to be a member of the band to which she formerly belonged and is now a member of the band of which her husband is a member. The same law now in force before the passage
