I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th Ultimo, No 277 704, enclosing Location Ticket No 880, Resolution of the Council of the Chippewas of the Thames and Declaration as to death intestate of Isaac Grosbeck and heirs left by him, and in reply to say that the Department approves of your action in allowing the children to remain with their Nother, as long as they are properly cared for and of your obtaining and forwarding agreement for lease in the usual way, in order that rental may be applied in payment of debts and in support of the children.
