
Ottawa Nov. 2nd, 1910.

Sir,-

With further reference to your letter of the 8th Sept. last, I beg to inform you that Mr. E. B. Drummond, Indian Agent, Lytton, B.C. was instructed to examine and value the land and damages and separately the damages to Indian improvements, in the Right of way required by the Canadian Northern Pacific Railway, through the Popkum Indian Reserve. He has reported that he estimates the value of the land to be \$135.00 per acre, which includes the standing timber.

Your amended plan shows the said Right of way to contain 9.59 acres; if you concur in the above valuation kindly remit the amount due, viz \$1294.65.
