
Ottawa, 5th January, 1914.

Sir,-

I beg to transmit herewith cheque No. 1560 for \$185.25 in payment for professional attendance which you rendered in August to Indians of the Caradoc Reserve, who were ill with measles and other diseases attendant thereon. \$26.84 charged on your account for attendance given on patients suffering from cramps and tuberculosis has been disallowed, as rendering such services forms part of your duties as salaried medical officer. The payment now made is settlement in full of all accounts due you by the Department for attendance in July and August.
