Please transmit following message to President Truman from
Prime Minister Mackenzie King. Begins.
1. I have been advised in strict confidence by the Canadian
representative on the Combined Food Board that the United States memb
has intimated to his colleagues on the Board the probability of the
United States discentinuing meat rationing on or about December 1st.
2. I have recent and vivid impressions of the urgent need for su
plies of meat in the United Kingdom and continental Europe and of the
extent to which they are relying on the cooperation of North America.
It is, however, because of the great importance of close cooperation be-
tween our two governments that I am sending this message.
3. In the course of several conversations both of us have agreed
on the great value of the intimate wartime collaboration through the
various Combined Boards, and we have also agreed on the desirability of
continuing a maximum degree of similar collaboration during the
difficult months that lie shead.
4. The discontinuance of meat rationing in the U.S.A. will raise
questions of policy in Canada which will require most careful examine
ation. In the light of desperate European needs during the coming
winter we feel that we should not discontinue meet rationing at the present juncture, and it is our present wimm intention to continue
meat rationing in full effect.
that the decisions of each country will react on the neighbouring Ends.
