He and another SUS were placing inflammable material on the A . legs of the hut. Who was the other SUS? Q. Gravel. A. Q. What was this inflammable material? Straw from the paliasses, dry boards, paliasses, board Α. from the beds. Do you know where the bed boards came from? Q. Handed up from the adjoining cell block A. Handed up by whom? Q. Other SUS. A . Were there other SUS around? Q. Yes, on the ground I would say approximately 25. A . In the base of the watch tower open or closed? Q. Open, Sir. A . Would you tell the Court what you saw being done? Q. The inflammable material was placed between the legs, the A . fire was lit and then I saw the SUS climbing the side facing the parade square and they a ttached some blankets to the side so that the flames could crawl up these. Did you see who it was who laid the fire? Q. No, Sir. A . Did you see flames? Q. Yes, Sir, the flames were in progress when the accused climber A . up. When you first saw the accused was it before or after you saw flames? Q. A. Before add
