Pioneer Fruit Farms, Matsqui, B.C. March 14, 1947 Dear Sir: Two days after the hangar at Chilliwack blew down the insurance adjuster told me they would consider my plane a total loss; and that they'd write to me in a few days. However they did not write for over a month.

When I got tired of waiting I informed the Dept. of Transport at Ottawa that BUZ had been destroyed. Yesterday I turned the plane over to the British Aviation Insurance Co. I believe they will sell what can be salvaged to the 'trade'. But you will have to contact Eric Beardmore of the B.A.I., Vancouver Branch, regarding the disposition of the wrecked ship. The C. of A. and C. of R. are in the office at Chilliwack Airport. I will get these papers and send them to you the next time I go there, which may be soon. Yours very truly, "H. Aish"
