SCALE OF WATER AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO.

A supply of Water daily, at the rate of three quarts for each Passenger, and at convenient times, not less often than 2 times a-week; a supply of Provisions after the rate of seven pounds of Bread, Biscuit, Flour, Oatmeal, or Rice, per week one half of the supply shall consist of Bread or Biscuit, and that Potatoes may be employed (at Master's option) to the extent of the remaining half of the supply, five pounds of the Potatoes being computed as equal to one pound of the other articles above enumerated, and that such issues, as aforesaid, shall be made throughout the whole Voyage, including the time of detention, if any, at any Port or Place before the end of such Voyage.
