N. B. In this Number is included 1120 Men which the Parliament provided for, to serve in other Parts, viz. One Regiment to serve in Portugal, Four in Flanders, & the Battalion of Guards on the Establishment of Guards & Garrisons.

For the Year 1707, the Numbers provided for, to serve in Spain and Portugal, were 29,295 Men, of which the Corps that serv'd in Spain, exclusive of Gibraltar, if complete, according to their Establishment, would amount to 25,141 Men. And adding the Battalion of Guards, and the Marines. 27141

N. B. Of this Number Six Regiments of Foot were reduc'd, and Officers sent Home for want of Money in March 1709.

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
