veyors of Highways within the several Towns or Parishes in this Province, and for suspending for a limited time all the Laws now in force relating to the Same.

After which Has Excellency was pleased to make the following Speech to both Houses—to wit:

His Excellency's fpeech.

- · Gentlemen of the Council,
  - and Gentlemen of the Assembly,
- S it may, at this advanced season, be inconvenient to the members, from distant counties to be longer detained, I now close the present Session, in hopes that such provisions for the public service as remain unsettled will, at your next meeting, be resumed and completed in such manner as may be most conducive to the permanent welfare and prosperity of the province.

And then the Clerk of the Crown, by His Excellency's command, declared the General Assembly to be prorogued to the fecond Tuesday in June next.
