RUSSIAN MOSQUITO FLEET SCORES IN THE BALTIC SEA

A Report From Denmark States a German Cruiser, a Destroyer, and Twelve Merchantmen Were Sunk—Berlin Admits Auxiliary Cruiser Was Lost.

London, June 15.—The German auxiliary cruiser Herzmann has been attacked and sunk in the Baltic south-east of Stockholm, by four Russian torpedo-boat destroyers, according to Berlin. Reports from Sweden and Denmark concerning the fight say that it was between Russian torpedo craft and a German auxiliary cruiser, some torpedo boats and armed trawlers, which were conveying German merchantmen. In addition to the auxiliary cruiser and a German destroyer, twelve of the merchantmen are reported to have been sunk.

The Berlin statement says: "During the night of June 13 the German auxiliary cruiser Herzmann was attacked by four Russian destroyers in the Bight, southeast of Stockholm. After a courageous resistance, the vessel was set afire by shells, and was blown up by her crew. The Commander and most of the crew were saved." DANISH PAPER'S VERSION. Copenhagen, June 15.—The German cruiser Koenig, voyager, a destroyer, and twelve merchantmen have been sunk in a sea fight in the Baltic, according to a report received by the Exchange Telegraph Company. The Dagens Nyheder publishes the following: "Fourteen German ships, conveyed by eight armed trawlers, the cruiser Koenig von Sachsen, and two destroyers, in the Baltic, were suddenly attacked by six Russian destroyers and submarines. The Germans fled. It is believed twelve of the merchantmen were sunk, a trawler has arrived at Nykoping, in Sweden, with 150 survivors of a German destroyer. The Koenig von Sachsen was sunk, with all hands. The following ten of the fourteen German steamers reported as having been lost in the attack of the Russian squadron are named by another Copenhagen paper as follows:—Norme, Unseely, Arda, Mucklenburg, Isselle, Italia, Deterro, Weser, Konsul Schultze and Algeba.

Describing the Baltic fight the Dagens Nyheder says that the Russian squadron won an important victory. The Russians had six destroyers and several submarines, and were going at such speed that the Germans were taken completely by surprise and fired only one shot, then making for port in the utmost haste. The action probably took place off Nykoping, a coast town in Sweden, about 40 miles southeast of Stockholm.

BOSELLI NEW ITALIAN LEADER. Baron Sonnino and General Morone to be Included in New Cabinet.

By Special Wire to the Courier. New York, June 15.—A news agency despatch from Rome says: Baron Sydney Sonnino, Italian minister of foreign affairs, and Gen. Morone, minister of war in the Salandra ministry are likely to retain their places in the new ministry, which will be formed by Palolo Bosselli at the request of King Victor Emmanuel.

None of the others is expected to be reappointed. Their places will be taken by representatives of the forces which compelled the Salandra resignation.

WOMEN WORKING 12 HOURS A DAY

Mining and Smelting Industries in Berlin Get Cheap Labor.

Berlin, June 14, via London, June 15.—Many women in the German mining and smelting industries are now working twelve hours daily, according to the president of the Hirschdunker labor unions, a non-socialist labor organization which is holding the annual convention in Berlin. The president said further that some soldier wives had asked to be employed only on night shifts, so that they might have a day for the care of their households and their children.

GETTING TO INNER DEFENCES. Germans Bombarding Positions North of Souville at Verdun.

Paris, June 15.—The Germans are continuing their violent bombardment of the French positions north of Souville, the key to the inner defences of Verdun, the official statement issued by the French war office to-day says: No infantry fighting occurred on either bank of the Meuse last night. On the Vosges front some minor German attempts to attack the French line were made but completely failed, according to the official statement.

DETAINED MAN IN LIVERPOOL. Traveller on Business Trip to Germany is Held Up by the Police.

London, June 15.—(New York Times cable)—The Daily News says the Liverpool police are detaining a German, Richard Hansemann, who travelled from New York aboard the St. Paul, with a passport issued by the German consulate in New York, his idea being to visit Germany.
