A By-law to acquire certain lands in the City of St. Catharines and to for the cost of same for the purpose of establishing athletic and recrea-

tion grounds thereon.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation deems it desirable to acquire the lands hereinafter described for the purpose of establishing athletic and recreation grounds for the use of the inhabitants of the City of St. Catharines at a cost of Ten Thousand Dollars.


