best Basis-How to Prepare It-Substitute Potting Soil - Bone

The best basis for all ordinary potting soils is well-rotted, tough, fibrous sod, taken from loamy or light elay loam soils. Sod from an old pasture field, or from the roadside, once. The sod should not be cut from near pine or cedar trees as the turpentine in the leaves or pinnae of these trees is very de-trimental to plant life. It is also best not to cut the sod from very swamp soil. Well-rotted barnyard manure such as from an old hot bed or cow manure, are both good ferti-liers to use for a soil compost. Horse manure alone is not a good fertilizer for a compost. About one-third horse manure and the balance cow manure will be suitable. Late in autumn or early spring is the best time to pre-

How to Prepare.-The sod should be cut about four inches thick, and bout eight to ten inches square. It should be stacked out of doors in an out-of-the-way part of the garden or days. brimmers and top builders. Apply grounds.
