Argentine shipments for the week were 45,000 bu. against 35,000 bu. the previous week, and 50,000 bu. a year ago. Exports reported 25 loads taken. Sea-board clearances in wheat and flour were equal to 25,000 bu. Estimated receipts tomorrow: Wheat, 95 cars; corn, 40 cars; oats, 10 cars; hogs, 2,000 head.
