




Immigration Figures For Year Show Slight Decrease-Many From Gt. Britain.

Ottawa, Jan. 23.—Immigration to
Canada for the calendar year 1924
otalled 124,450 according to an oficial statement by the department of
mmigration and colonization. This
otal is made up of 57,612 from Great
Sritain and Ireland; 18,328 from the
United States and 50,510 from other
countries.

In the calendar year for 1923 the total immigration to Canada was 137,320, so that in 1924 there was a decrease of 12,870 or nine per cent. But this total, says the statement, does not take into consideration the 37,317 Canadians who have returned home since April 1 last, from the United States after having lived there for six months or longer. 
