BETTER CAR SERVICE.

The Council and the Toronto Railway Company.

The Board of Works will meet Monday afternoon to consider Engineer Keating's report.

Referring to the Gerrard-street car service, the Engineer says the company discontinued the service along Parliament and Gerrard-streets without his authority.

They ran the Winchester cars down Parliament, leaving Gerrard to be served by the popular T.M. Collie cars.

The company has been written to, asking that the Parliament-street cars be replaced and that the Winchester cars be run down Yonge-street.
