On sale of Bills of Exchange, with endorsement. \$3 1/2	
On sale of Bills of Exchange without endorsement. \$1	
For endorsing Bills of Exchange when desired. \$2 1/2	
On sale of produce from California and Oregon, Washington Territory, and Sandwich Island ports, with guarantee. \$7 1/2	
On sale of Merchandise from other ports, with guarantee. \$10

 The foregoing commissions to be exclusive of Brokerage and every charge actually incurred.

SCHEDULE II.

Rates of Storage on Merchandise.  
 STORAGE PER MO.  
 On measurement goods \$1 00 per ton of 40 cubic feet.  
 On heavy goods \$1 00 per ton of 2000 lbs.  
 Or in either case the amount actually paid.  
 The consignee to have the option of charging by weight or measurement.  
 A fraction of a month to be charged as a month.

REGULATIONS.

Concerning Delivery of Merchandise, Payment of Freight, etc.  
 When no express stipulation exists for Bill of Lading, goods are to be considered as deliverable on shore.  
 Freight on all goods to be paid, or secured to the satisfaction of the captain or consignee of the vessel prior to the delivery of the goods.  
 After delivery to the purchaser of goods sold, no claims for damage, deficiency or other cause, shall be admissible unless made within three days, and no such claims shall be admissible after goods sold and delivered have once left the city.  
 When foreign Bills of Lading expressly stipulate that the freight shall be paid in a specific coin, then the same must be procured if required, or its equivalent given, the rate to be determined by the current value at the time at the Banks.
