

The Mosque of Omar.

THIS famous structure occupies the site of the first and second temples at Jerusalem, and its area includes much of the oldest structures of the sacred city. Its Turkish name means "Dome of the Rock." It is so called because immediately under the dome a huge mass of the native rock protrudes through the marble pavement. This is alleged to have been the site of the great altar of sacrifice. Beneath it is a cave and openings which are described as the channels for conveying away the blood of the sacrifices.
