AGREEMENT ON DEVELOPMENT CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand,

Wishing to strengthen the existing cordial relations between the two countries and their peoples, and

Desiring to foster development co-operation between the two countries in conformity with the objectives of economic and social development of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand,

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand shall promote a programme of development co-operation, between their two countries, consisting of the following components:

- (a) the sending of appraisal and evaluation missions to Thailand to study and analyze development projects;
- (b) the granting of scholarships to Thai nationals for studies and professional training in Canada, Thailand, or a third country;
- (c) the assignment of Canadian experts, advisers and other specialists to Thailand;
- (d) the provision of equipment, materials, goods and services required for the successful execution of development projects in Thailand;
- (e) the development and carrying out of studies and projects designed to contribute to the attainment of the objectives of this Agreement;
- (f) the encouragement and promotion of relations between firms, institutions and persons of the two countries; and
- (g) any other form of assistance which may mutually agreed upon.

ARTICLE II

1. In support of the objectives of this Agreement, the Government of Canada and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand may conclude subsidiary arrangements in respect of specific projects involving one or several components of the programme described in Article I.
