 - (2) 954,000 square yards of filament polyester sheer fabric (such as voile, batiste, chiffon) and pongee fabrics may be exported to Canada in addition to this quantitative limit in the calendar year 1980. Within this total, either of the two items shall not exceed the level of 636,000 square yards.
