


CANADA/SASKATCHEWAN AGREEMENT

The Government of Canada, hereinafter referred to as Canada, and the Government of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as Saskatchewan,

Have agreed as follows:


1. Saskatchewan shall be designated by Canada as the responsible Canadian entity for the purposes set out in Article X(1) of the Agreement between the United States of America and Canada for Water Supply and Flood Control in the Souris River Basin, to be signed at Washington, D.C., on October 26, 1989, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement", and shall honour all the terms of the Agreement.
2. Saskatchewan shall indemnify and save harmless Canada from and in respect to any liability of Canada to the United States of America arising under the Agreement.

Signed at Regina and Ottawa this 23rd day of October 1989, and this 16th day of November 1989, in two copies.
