Article 1

The Convention on Social Security between Canada and Luxembourg signed at Ottawa on May 22, 1986 shall be amended as follows:

- (A) The following paragraph shall replace paragraph 1 (b) of Article II:
 - " (b) with respect to Luxembourg:

to the legislation concerning pension insurance in the case of old age, disability or survivors."

(B) The following article shall replace Article III:

ARTICLE III

Unless otherwise provided in this Convention, it shall apply to persons who are or who have been subject to the legislation of one or both Parties as well as those who derive their rights from these persons."

- (C) Paragraph 7 of Article VI is deleted.
- (D) The following text shall replace Part III:

PART III PROVISIONS CONCERNING BENEFITS

CHAPTER 1 TOTALIZING OF PERIODS

ARTICLE VIII

1. If a person is not entitled to the payment of a benefit because he or she has not accumulated sufficient periods of insurance under the legislation of a Party, entitlement to the payment of that benefit shall be determined by
