

What's New on the DRP

Easier, Faster, Better

A new "Simple Version" of The DFAIT Research Page (DRP) front end, and a new category called "HQ Info. Resources" has recently been created and designed for those who prefer less graphic intensive or graphic reliant home pages. The Simple Version features smaller icons for faster downloading and a neutral white background. It is designed to provide all the links, even if the Auto Load Images option in Netscape is turned off. Users should be aware, however, that, increasingly, sites on the Internet provide graphical image maps for navigational purposes with no alternatives.
