

Article 2

Scope

This Agreement sets out security procedures and practices for the exchange of Classified Information and Designated Information between the Parties, for the protection of Transmitted Information and for visits.

Article 3

National Security Authorities

The National Security Authorities of the Parties shall be responsible for the implementation of this Agreement. Unless otherwise advised by a Party in writing, the National Security Authorities for the Parties shall be:

Article 4

Marking of Transmitted Information

1. Before transmission to the receiving Party, the originating Party shall assign all recorded Transmitted Information with one of the security classifications, or in the case of the Government of Canada, if applicable, a designation indication, and shall mark the assigned security classification or designation indication and the name of the country of the originating Party on all recorded Transmitted Information.
2. The Party receiving Classified Information shall ensure that the Classified Information received from the originating Party and anything incorporating the Classified Information, when in recorded form, is marked with a national security classification at a level no lower than the level corresponding to the level specified by the originating Party,
