I know of one incident where I had to ask an editor to be very careful of identifying a possible site, and that was done at the request of the security people at the time. However, I know of no circumstance in which anything was imposed on anyone. In fact, there was cooperation either to be very careful about police investigation in order not to indicate what might be a location.
