

and qualified persons summoned for life to fill the same as now, under the said Act; but leaving the selection of one half of said persons to the Provincial Governments of the respective Provinces entitled to said seats. The right of selecting such persons beginning always with the Provincial Governments and alternating thereafter; and the motion in amendment to the amendment of the Honourable Mr. David by striking out of the said amendment all the words in the second line thereof, after the words "in lieu thereof," and inserting the following:—

"This House is prepared to give careful consideration to any proposition which may be submitted to it by the Government for the amendment and improvement of the constitution of Parliament."—(Hon. Mr. Domville.)
