It is constructed upon a due consideration of attraction of the Sun and Moon in their several positions respecting. Earth, and serves to show what kind of weather will most probably ow the entrance of the Moon into any of her quarters:—

The nearer midnight any of the Moon's changes occur, the finer will the weather during the succeeding week; the nearer noon any of one changes happen, the more foul and wet will be the weather that If follow.
