FIRST SEDERUNT.

At the City of Hamilton, and within Central Church there, the Fourteenth day of June, One thousand, eight hundred and ninety-nine, at eight o'clock in the evening:

Which time and place ministers and ruling elders, commissioners from the several Presbyteries of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, convened pursuant to appointment by the General Assembly held in the City of Montreal, on the seventeenth day of June last year.

The Rev. Robert Torrance, D.D., of Guelph, Moderator of the last General Assembly, conducted public worship, and preached a sermon from the words contained in Zechariah, second chapter, fifth verse: "I, saith the Lord will be the glory in the midst of her," and then by prayer constituted the General Assembly in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, the only King and Head of the Church.

ROLL CALL.
