all its proceedings and transactions, such as are proper to be written, shall be duly recorded, and which are to be approved and confirmed at every regular Monthly meeting.

The Master of this Lodge, or some Brother appointed by him as Secretary shall keep a Book, in which shall be inserted the names of the Members, and of all persons initiated or admitted therein, with the dates of their proposal, admission, or initiation, passing and raising, and also their ages at the time, and their titles, trades, or professions, together with the several sums received for initiation and joining fees, and Monthly dues.
