I agree to the following Article of the Regulations of the "QUEBEC BATEAUMEN BENEVOLENT SOCIETY," to wiz:

Article 39e .- " Every bateau going "along side of a vessel before noon, "must be unloaded or discharged at "6 o'clock P. M., at the latest. When " in the afternoon, must be discharged, " at the latest, the next day before noon. "Once discharged or unloaded after "the above hours, \$6.00 for demurrage " shall be paid for every day of deten-"tion, including also the day upon "which the bateau ought to be dis-"charged." Which \$6.00 demurrage for every day of detention shall be due and payable \$3.00 to each bateauman, when more than on day of detention, and the \$6.00 to the head-man of the bateau, if only one day of detention, occurs.
