

1860, £3 10s. ; a bill for printing and stationery in 1860, £4 2s. 5d. ; in all, £353 2s. 5d., leaving the actual balance at the disposal of the Committee, £21 11s. 3d.

In conclusion, the Executive Committee expresses a hope that if the present Report be found deficient in its usual matter of interest, some allowance may be made for the shortness of the time since the last was published.
