SPRUCE LAKE MILL EMPLOYS 18 MEN

A portable mill on the William Abel property near Spruce Lake now is employing 18 men in the manufacture of laths and planks for the Wilson Box Co., Ltd., and for export to the United States. It is being operated by Joseph Bonnevie, and it is expected the mill will manufacture about 700,000 feet of logs this season. The lumber was cut during the winter by R. M. McFarlane of Sussex. He employed 25 men and four double teams in cutting and hauling. Of the 700,000 feet of logs, a Hampton man has undertaken to cut and split 300 cords for firewood.




