## GHOU AFTER MONEY IN CORPSE'S MOUTH

Told Police Drowned Man Was Friend—  
Robbed Sailor, Jumped Overboard  
With \$15 In Teeth.

NEW YORK, July 22.—Michael Murphy, an East Side character, was interrupted last night in the cheerful operation of prying open the mouth of a corpse, and thereby hangs a mystery. Murphy is held by the police. When discovered in an undertaking establishment fumbling with the man's body, who he says was a friend of his, Murphy admitted that he was looking for money. Examination thereupon revealed three \$5 bills in the dead man's mouth. They had been there since Sunday last when Andrew Erickson, whose blue lips were closed over the currency, met death in Jamaica Bay. To the police Murphy told a weird story. He said he and Erickson had lured a drunken sailor to a boat and had robbed him. Then the car broke, says Murphy, and Erickson, stuffing part of the money in his mouth to keep it dry, jumped overboard after it. He sank, says Murphy, but the police think there may have been a struggle, for Erickson's head bears a deep gash.

## BREDDING OPERATIONS SPOILING THE BATHING

## HANS HOLMER COMES BACK HOME

Marathon Runner Finds Mother  
in New York.

Left Home When a Youngster, Saying He  
Would Return When Famous,  
and He Did.

NEW YORK, July 22.—Mrs. Alice Holmer, wife of Peter Holmer, an electrical engineer, of 366 Bronx Park avenue, West Farms, was making bread in her kitchen early yesterday afternoon, thinking among other things, of the little son who had run away in anger nine years before, when his family, smaller and more comfortable than now, lived in an old farm house in Southern Boulevard, near 178th street. That boy was her eldest, and she was sure he was dead, for never a word of him or from him had she heard.

At just about that time there stood before a row of brick tenements on Southern Boulevard, near 178th street, a tall, athletic-looking young man. He was Hans Holmer, champion Marathon runner of Canada, whose long swinging stride had carried him to the victor last Saturday in the Marathon race at Atlantic City.
