MONTREAL, April - Condemnation of those who hoard wealth and those who defraud the unemployed coupled with an appeal to people to turn from Mammon to Christ, were contained in the annual charge to his clergy by Right Rev. John Farthing, Bishop of Montreal, in opening the 94th annual session of the Anglican Synod of Montreal at the Parish Hall of Christ Church Cathedral.

"The dominating spirit of the world is selfishness, which is ever divisive. Thus we see individuals arrested one against another, class against class, nation against nation, each seeking its own, and neither considering the other except so far as the one can use the other to further his own ends; and when those ends have been served the victors are often times only too ready to turn against those who served them."
