

GOVERNMENT OF INDIA CONTROLS WHEAT EXPORTS

State to employ as Agents firms that have been Chief Exporters in the past - Reasons for adoption of measures set forth

Calcutta, India, May 12.—Reference has been made from time to time to the various measures which the government of India has adopted in view of the serious rise which has taken place during the past few months in the price of wheat.

This move was announced at the Imperial Legislative Council in Delhi recently, by the Hon. W. H. Clark, member of the government of India who is specially charged with commercial and industrial interests.

Dardanelles.

Mr. Clark then went on to mention that the Dardanelles were closed just when the Russian crop was beginning to move and probably 2,000,000 tons of Russian wheat were locked up in the Black sea.

India had in sight now, Mr. Clark said, one of the largest crops ever harvested in that country, and the primary problems before the government had been how to modify the effect in India of a world market, or in other words how to remove India from the world market.

If, however, some export was to be permitted, the question arose how it was to be controlled.

The firms employed would buy at the prices fixed by the government and up to the quantities fixed. Wheat would be shipped in the main to London, and would be sold there through ordinary commercial agencies on behalf of the government.

The essence of the scheme, continued Mr. Clark, is that government will have the power of fixing the prices at which purchases are to take place in India for export, or rather above which they are not to take place.

The intention of the government was that the prices at which buying would commence for April shipment should be relatively high as compared with prices subsequently to be fixed.
