

He said that Australia lost as many men as the United States in the war end has as much right to vote as the United States. President Wilson recognized "the justice and fair."

Rome, Dec. 27.—Italians will not in the future emigrate to the United States because wine is not obtainable there, Signor Bettini announced in the Senate today. He recommended that the government, in order to keep pace with the tremendous rise in population, facilitate emigration to Brazil, which country, he said, had always treated Italians with favor.
